

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Do you offer courses for all levels of proficiency?

A. Yes, we offer courses for beginner to advanced levels.

Q. Do you work with all sizes of organizations in any types of sectors?

A. Yes, our clients include professional individuals, business owners, and large organizations across various sectors: accounting, financial, insurance, legal, non-profit, technology.

Q. Do I have to be in Toronto to take courses with Premiere Class?

A. Premiere Class is a company specializing in teaching French to professionals in Toronto (Greater Toronto Area) and Ottawa (National Capital Region). We can teach French online to students all across Ontario and Canada.

Q. How do you determine your students' level in French?

A. Our students take an oral assessment before their first class. This friendly conversation *en français* with a language consultant enables us to determine their level in French. They are then advised what training program is most suitable for them according to their goal. This assessment will last for a maximum of 20 minutes.

Q. We would like our teacher to come to our office. Are there any additional fees?

A. We teach French at our clients' location in downtown Toronto (GTA) and Ottawa (National Capital Region) at no additional cost.

Q. How long does your program last?

A. Our course outline is based on the Common European Framework of Reference for languages (CEFR), a tool for teaching French as a Second Language in Canada and worldwide. We offer 10-hour contracts for private classes and 24-hour contracts for group classes, so our students monitor progress towards their learning achievement.

Q. What is your teaching style?

A. We teach French by focusing on interacting with a communicative approach (role play, professional presentation, writing e-mails, etc.). We incorporate multimedia resources to enhance our students' learning process and to practice the 4 skills of language: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.
